Advanced Political Leadership Program 2024



A PARTNERSHIP BETWEEN



Advanced Political Leadership is a cohort based, face-to-face program designed to help you prepare for ministerial life, and enhance impact and influence through your career.

This unique program challenges participants to lead effectively, legitimately and with an understanding of their democratic stewardship responsibilities. It has been developed with insights from experienced and successful political leaders, and evolved with detailed feedback from past participants. The curriculum is practical and applied, and challenges participants to prepare for their future roles through a combination of self-reflection, structured small group work and whole-of-cohort dialogues.

Supported by professional facilitation, participants will hear from and engage with an unparalleled line up of:

- Former leaders, ministers and senior advisers;
- Highly respected policy and public service leaders; and
- Global thought leaders on a range of policy, politics and leadership topics.

Advanced Political Leadership is a non-partisan program that is open to MPs from the federal, state and territory parliaments. It is expected that participants will have had no or minimal ministerial experience and have reasonable prospects for a ministerial career.

PROGRAM INFORMATION

Advanced Political Leadership explores the major structures and trends that shape democracies and societies, and the dilemmas they pose for leaders. It unpacks the mindsets and skill sets needed of today's political leaders.

Mindsets:

- Learning mindset: A commitment to formation through continuous and lifelong learning, acknowledging the forces in political life that may work against this.
- **Democratic stewardship:** A commitment to respecting our parliamentary and democratic institutions, and accepting some responsibility for them.

Skill sets:

- Leading change: Building a solid understanding of the major frameworks used to develop your leadership skills and of the ways that leadership is evolving to meet new challenges.
- **Managing self and role:** Maintaining wellbeing, balance and performance in work and life, setting priorities and an understanding of the tasks and responsibilities of ministerial leadership.
- Solving public problems: Understand and apply key policy frameworks and tools that enable leaders to tackle today's policy, societal and democratic challenges.
- Working with others: Understand the why, when and how of partnerships, built on an analysis of power dynamics and the tools of negotiation.



The total cost of the program is \$24,000 (plus GST). Successful applicants will be provided with a full scholarship funded by the McKinnon Institute, covering the costs of tuition, accommodation and all meals and refreshments.

PROGRAM FACILITATORS



Professor Rod Glover is CEO & Academic Director of the McKinnon Institute. One of Australia's leading thinkers on policy reform, Rod's roles have included Senior Adviser to the Prime Minister and Deputy Secretary of Victoria's Department of Premier and Cabinet.



Professor Anne Tiernan is Head of Research at the McKinnon Institute. One of Australia's most eminent political scientists, Anne has been at the forefront of debates about Australian democracy and the relevance of its democratic institutions.

INDEPENDENT SELECTION PANEL

Those chosen to participate in Advanced Political Leadership are selected by an independent panel comprising a former senior public servant (as Chair), and a former senior Liberal and Labor Minister.



Peter Woolcott AO was the Australian Public Service Commissioner from 2018 to 2023, and was Prime Minister Turnbull's Chief of Staff from 2017-2018. Prior to that Woolcott was High Commissioner to New Zealand, Ambassador to the United Nations in Geneva, Ambassador to Italy and Consul General to Hawaii responsible for liaison with US Pacific Command. He was also Ambassador for People Smuggling Issues and Ambassador for the Environment which included being the lead negotiator for Australia and Chair of the Umbrella Group which produced the Paris Climate Change Agreement (2016). Woolcott retired from Government in 2023 and was appointed a Vice-Chancellor's Professorial Fellow at Monash University.



The Hon. Marise Payne is an accomplished, considered strategic leader, highly experienced in foreign policy, national security and strategic issues. She served as Australia's Minister for Defence and Minister for Foreign Affairs. Her career focus is on working closely with allies and partners and developing key relationships to deliver greater strategic strength and resilience.



The Hon. Andrew Fraser was a Labor Member of the Queensland Parliament from 2004 to 2012, and was Treasurer of Queensland from 2007 to 2012. He was the second youngest Treasurer in Queensland's history (at age 30). In his political career, Andrew also held the portfolios of Deputy Premier, Employment, Economic Development, State Development and Trade. Post-politics, Andrew has been a professional director with a wide range of roles across the private, public and charitable sectors. In 2022, he was appointed as Chancellor of Griffith University.

IS THIS PROGRAM RIGHT FOR ME?

Advanced Political Leadership helps to prepare parliamentarians to be ministers. It is targeted at federal, state or territory parliamentarians who have not had significant recent experience as a minister. Shadow Ministers, Assistant Ministers and Parliamentary Secretaries, in particular, are encouraged to apply. Advanced Political Leadership does require a significant time commitment from its participants, with attendance required at all workshops. The criteria taken into account by the independent selection panel in assessing applications are demonstrated leadership potential, personal drive, self-awareness, adaptability and willingness to learn.

HOW TO APPLY

Applications are now invited for the McKinnon Institute's flagship program Advanced Political Leadership 2024, for current members of parliament who are potential ministers in the short to medium term.

To submit your application, send an email to **apl@mckinnoninstitute.org.au** including your full CV, and a short response (max 500 words in total) to the following questions:

- What drew you to a political career and what is the legacy you would like to leave?
- What policy challenge do you care most about and wish to have an impact on?
- Why have you applied for Advanced Political Leadership?

Formal applications will be assessed by the independent selection panel and candidates will be notified of the outcome of their application in May 2024.

It is expected that a maximum of 20 participants will be selected.


